

ARTICLE 30

TECHNOLOGY AND RELATED CONTRACT PROVISIONS

30.1 In recognition of the fact that technological devices and software are changing rapidly and that no contract provision can foresee the nature of these changes, the District and the Association agree to form a Technology for Instruction Oversight Committee to make recommendations to the superintendent or his/her designee and the Association President or his/her designee proposing appropriate actions to deal with such technological changes. The Association and the District agree that recommendations are to relate only to the issues at hand and are not to apply to future circumstances, which must be examined on their own merits.

30.1.1 The Committee shall be composed of the Tech Coaches, nine (9) Association appointees (one per each school site), two (2) District appointees and one (1) mutually agreed upon classified and/or management appointee.

30.1.2 The Committee shall conduct a technology and technology-related needs assessment.

30.1.3 The Committee shall recommend equipment, network access and software selection use and staff development; as well as revision or alteration of procedures for computer use or for pupil supervision and other district wide instructional technology decisions.

The District and Association direct the Technology for Instruction Committee to review the purpose and structure of the committee and make recommendations for necessary revisions.

30.2 The Association shall have the use of the District e-mail/website to communicate with their unit members.
